The Alberta International Medical Graduate Program (AIMGP) is one of Canada's most comprehensive programs assessing IMG applicants for entry into post-graduate residency training. Our Program increases the number of International Medical Graduates (IMGs) eligible to work as medical doctors in Alberta by providing qualified IMGs who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents residing in Alberta with access to postgraduate medical education in high-need specialties. The Government of Alberta established the AIMG Program in 2001.

We are seeking a strong leader who shows initiative, builds and maintains strong relationships, is highly knowledgeable in education, assessment and policy development and can direct and prioritize in a balanced and transparent manner.

You will be responsible for nurturing relationships with members of the Faculties of Medicine, overseeing the work of physician consultants, enhancing and maintaining assessment tools (e.g. OSCE bank), chairing the AIMGP OSCE committee, and further developing the educational curriculum for AIMG orientation.

As the **Medical Director** you will report directly to the Program's Managing Director, work closely with the Program's Steering Committee, the Province's two Faculties of Medicine, their respective Residency Program Directors, and Alberta Health & Wellness.

As the ideal candidate, you have a medical degree with at least 3 years of clinical practice in Alberta with experience in evaluation, curriculum development and as an educator. You should ideally have achieved this experience at the University of Alberta's or University of Calgary's Faculties of Medicine in a management, healthcare or academic environment. You are also culturally aware and sensitive, have strong communication skills, and work in a collaborative manner. You have experience in working with other medical educators, Government, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta and working with Universities and the Residency Programs in Alberta.

This is a part-time (1-2 days per week) negotiable contract position currently based in Calgary.
